- Private, nonprofit (501c3) school for grades K-12; 1.853 students enrolled since 1982
- Serving students in grades K-5 with specific learning disabilities and students in grades 6-12 with specific learning disabilities and/or attention deficit disorders
- Specific learning disabilities may include diagnoses such as: reading, written expression, or math disorders; dyslexia and dysgraphia; language processing deficits
- Offering full-day school program, afterschool programs, tutoring, and summer programs
- Enrollment projected for 2016-17: 262 students; currently 63% male, 37% female
- Student to teacher ratio: 6 students to 1 teacher
- College preparatory curriculum based on North Carolina course of study
- Individualized, structured, multisensory program based on Orton-Gillingham approach


