2010 Summer Programs

The Fletcher School Summer Programs are designed to provide students with learning disabilities and/or attention deficit disorders an opportunity to maintain and improve academic skills during the summer. Students benefit from additional reinforcement of newly learned skills or further remediation of weaknesses using multisensory techniques in a structured classroom setting.

Programs are open to Fletcher and non-Fletcher students as specified. Classes have limited enrollment in order to maintain our six-to-one student-teacher ratio. Enrollment will be filled on a first-come, first-served basis.

- The Fletcher School reserves the right to cancel a program or class due to inadequate enrollment. All fees are refunded for cancelled classes.
- **Registration deadline is June 4, 2010.**
- The deposit or total tuition must accompany the registration form. Refund of this payment less a \$50 processing fee is available until June 4, 2010 ***if requested in writing***. After June 4, all payments are non-refundable.
- **The balance of tuition is due by June 4, 2010.**
- *Note: Current Fletcher parents may choose to have their account drafted for all payments. Please indicate your choice of payment on the registration form.*
- Tuition cannot be prorated for absences or partial attendance.
- Only students enrolled in a 1:00 pm class may stay on campus from 12:30-1:00 pm for lunch. Lunch must be brought from home.
- Students are not allowed to stay on campus if they are not attending a class. Students may not arrive earlier than 5 minutes prior to the start of their afternoon class.
- Students should bring morning and afternoon snacks from home as needed.
- Dress during the summer is informal and comfortable, but students must dress in a manner that indicates pride in themselves. Footwear must be worn at all times. T-shirts may be worn, but may not have suggestive or offensive graphics or messages.
- Smoking is strictly prohibited on campus.
- The use or possession of alcohol or drugs on campus will result in immediate dismissal without refund.

Individual Tutoring

Grades: Rising 1st - 12th

Dates: June 14 - August 13

Times: Individually scheduled

Cost: \$65.00 per hour (5, 10, or 15 hour blocks)

One-on-one tutoring by Fletcher School tutors will be available throughout the summer. Tutoring sessions are designed to meet the individual needs of the student in phonics, reading comprehension, written expression, math, computer keyboarding, study skills/learning strategies and high school academic subjects as requested.

Hourly tutoring sessions can be scheduled in the morning or the afternoon to suit your child's schedule. You must sign up for a minimum of 5 hours of tutoring during the summer. Tutoring hours are prepaid in increments of five hours (i.e. 5, 10, 15 hour blocks). Tutoring will be scheduled only for the number of prepaid hours. Schedule requests should take into consideration vacation, camps, and other plans to prevent missed sessions. Only sessions canceled 24 hours in advance will be rescheduled.

Tutors from The Fletcher School will tutor on campus using appropriate Fletcher School materials. Students will be placed with a tutor by the Tutoring Coordinator with consideration given to recommendations made by the child's current teacher. Parents should not contact teachers directly to set up tutoring.

Upon receipt of the initial payment of \$325 (5 hours) and completed registration form, the assigned tutor will contact the parent to arrange the summer schedule. Those who register for 10 or 15 hour blocks must pay the remaining balance in full by June 4, 2010 in order for tutoring schedules to be confirmed.

This program is designed for new Fletcher students to have an introduction to Fletcher's classroom environment and instructional programs. Returning Fletcher students will benefit from the opportunity to practice and review skills prior to the coming school year.

Core Academic Program

(for students not currently attending Fletcher)

Grades: Rising 2nd - 8th

Dates: June 28 - July 16 *(three week session)*
Closed Monday, July 5

Times: 9:00 am - 12:30 pm

Cost: \$800.00

Consistent with our academic year program, classes are taught in a six-to-one student-teacher ratio using a structured, multisensory approach to learning. Each student is placed in a group within a narrow age/grade range according to his/her skill needs.

Instruction is designed to begin on a student's current level and move from the known to the unknown gaining mastery of skills through practice and repetition. Students experience improved self-esteem in addition to academic gains.

Progress reports commenting on behaviors and academic skills in each class are written at the end of the third week. A parent conference is held for each student at the end of the session to discuss progress and make recommendations.

All non-Fletcher students registering for The Core Academic Program will be given an admissions assessment to determine proper placement. A non-refundable assessment fee of \$50 will be due with the deposit and registration form. If a space is not available for the student, the \$200 deposit will be refunded.

Afternoon Enrichment Camp

Grades: Rising 2nd - 8th

Dates: June 28 - July 30 (*one week sessions*)

Times and Cost:

1:00 - 3:00 pm = \$150 per week (2 hours)

1:00 - 4:00 pm = \$225 per week (3 hours)

1:00 - 5:00 pm = \$300 per week (4hours)

Our Enrichment Camp may be paired with our morning programs to provide a full-day schedule or chosen as a stand-alone afternoon program. A variety of activities will be offered each week including art, computer keyboarding, Spanish, fitness/yoga and drama. Please register for 2, 3, or 4 hours daily for one or more weeks.

Students enrolled in morning programs will be supervised by teachers from 12:30-1:00 pm to eat lunch brought from home. An afternoon snack should also be sent from home.

HANDWRITING WITHOUT TEARS®

Grades/Times:

Rising 2nd - 3rd: 1:00 - 2:00 pm

Rising 4th - 5th: 2:00 - 3:00 pm

Dates: July 19 - 30 (two-week session)

Cost: \$250

This handwriting program, designed by an occupational therapist, encourages proper formation of all cursive letters and lessens the opportunities for mistakes and frustration.

Groups will begin with lower case letters and move at an appropriate pace to ensure success. Capital letters may be introduced if appropriate. Classes will be taught by occupational therapist, Jeanmarie Tommasulo, OTR/L.

COMPUTER KEYBOARDING

Grades/Times:

The Herzog System of Keyboarding will be used to help students learn correct fingering for the entire alphabet and punctuation. Students will also work to improve speed and accuracy. Students may register for one or both weeks.
