Design the next lesson based on performance.

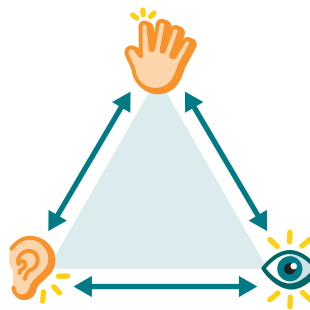


Individualized

Hear it, see it, and feel it, all at the same time.

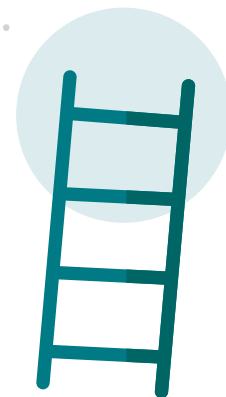


Direct & Explicit
